投票日投票的七個簡單步驟:

Seven simple steps to vote on the polling day:

1. 你<u>必須</u>帶備選民登記冊所記錄的身分證明文件(例如香港身份證或護照)<u>正本</u>,前 往背頁所示的投票站,以申領選票。若你只出示身分證明文件副本,將不會獲發 選票。(請參閱《申領選票所須的文件》)

You <u>must</u> bring along the <u>original</u> of your identity document (e.g. Hong Kong Identity Card or passport) recorded in the Register of Electors to the polling station shown overleaf to apply for a ballot paper. If you only produce a copy of such an identity document, you will not be issued a ballot paper. (Please refer to the Documents Required for Collecting Ballot Paper)

2. 若你只是居民代表選舉的選民,你會獲發一張<u>白色</u>的居民代表選舉選票及一塊繫有"✓"號印章的**白色**紙板。

If you are a Resident Representative Election ("ReRE") elector only, you will be issued with one <u>white</u> ReRE ballot paper and a <u>white</u> cardboard to which a "✓" chop is attached.

3. 若你只是原居民代表選舉的選民,你會獲發一張<u>紅色</u>的原居民代表選舉選票及一 塊繫有"✓"號印章的**紅色**紙板。

If you are an Indigenous Inhabitant Representative Election ("IIRE") elector only, you will be issued with one <u>red</u> IIRE ballot paper and a <u>red</u> cardboard to which a "\scriv" chop is attached.

若你同時是居民代表及原居民代表選舉的選民,你會同時獲發一張<u>白色</u>的居民代表選舉選票、一張<u>紅色</u>的原居民代表選舉選票,以及一塊繫有"✓"號印章的<u>紅白</u>色條紋紙板。

If you are an elector of both ReRE and IIRE, you will be issued with one <u>white</u> ReRE ballot paper, one <u>red</u> IIRE ballot paper and a cardboard with <u>red and white stripes</u> to which a "✓" chop is attached.

- 4. 在你獲發選票及紙板後,你必須立即進入劃票間填劃選票:
 - 就居民代表選舉而言,選民只可投選<u>一名</u>候選人。你<u>必須</u>用繫在紙板上的<u>印</u> **章**在你所選的候選人姓名相對的圓圈內蓋上單一個"✓"號。

• 就原居民代表選舉而言,選民只可投選一名候選人。你必須用繫在紙板上的 **印章**在你所選的候選人姓名相對的圓圈內蓋上單一個 "✓"號。

When you are issued with the ballot paper(s) and the cardboard, you must immediately go into the voting compartment to mark the ballot paper(s) –

For ReRE, an elector can only vote for <u>one</u> candidate. You <u>must</u> use the <u>chop</u> attached to the cardboard to affix a single "✓" in the circle opposite the name of the candidate of your choice.

For IIRE, an elector can only vote for <u>one</u> candidate. You <u>must</u> use the <u>chop</u> attached to the cardboard to affix a single " \checkmark " in the circle opposite the name of the candidate of your choice.

- 5. 填劃選票後,請將選票摺疊令已填劃的一面向內,以遮蓋選票上的投票選擇,然 後離開劃票間。
 - After marking the ballot paper(s), you should fold the ballot paper(s) so that the marked side is inside to conceal your vote before leaving the voting compartment.
- 6. 將已摺疊的<u>白色</u>選票(如有的話)放入已上鎖及密封的<u>白色</u>投票箱,及/或將已摺疊的<u>紅色</u>選票(如有的話)放入已上鎖及密封的<u>紅色</u>投票箱。在離開投票站前,請將 紙板及印章交還給看管投票箱的投票站工作人員。

Please put the folded <u>white</u> ballot paper (if any) into the locked and sealed <u>white</u> ballot box and/or put the folded <u>red</u> ballot paper (if any) into the locked and sealed <u>red</u> ballot box. Before leaving the polling station, please return the cardboard and the chop to the polling staff manning the ballot box(es).
