A nomination for the candidates of each of the above Villages must be completed in the specified form and delivered by the nominated candidate **in person** (except where the Returning Officer has, on application, authorized any other manner of submission) to the Returning Officer for the Village concerned at the above address. The nomination form must be delivered to the Returning Officer for the Village concerned during ordinary business hours (i.e. from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday and from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Saturday) from 22 October 2024 to 4 November 2024 (both days inclusive other than a general holiday).

Specified nomination forms may be obtained free of charge during ordinary business hours on any day between 10 October 2024 to 4 November 2024 (other than a general holiday) from the offices of the Returning Officers at the above addresses, or from the office of Home Affairs Department at 30th Floor, Southorn Centre, 130 Hennessy Road, Wan Chai, Hong Kong, or can be downloaded from the website of the Rural Representative Election (<https://www.had.gov.hk/rre>).

If there is more than one validly nominated candidate for any of the above Villages, a poll will be held for the Village on 1 December 2024.
