Personality Development and Group Support

Personality Development Courses, **Mutual Support Groups** and **Youth Development Programme** aim to increase self-confidence, self-esteem, leadership and coping skills of participants.

Volunteer Training and Activities create opportunities for locals and ethnic minorities to interact through assisting in HOPE Centre activities, to develop their potential, and learn to be a facilitator of different programmes.

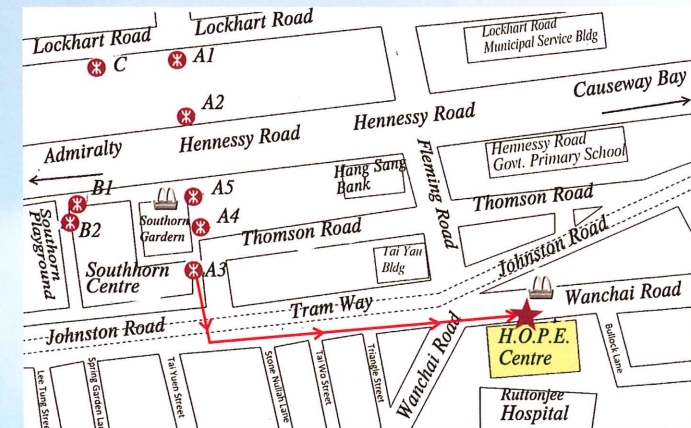

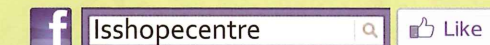
